The parish received its semi-annual disbursement of funds from Upon This Rock on January 31, 2021. This payment of 3,360.07. represents the parish's percentage of donations received by Upon This Rock from June 1, 2020 through November 30, 2020.

A special thank you goes out to those parishioners who continue to honor their pledges. Foremost, because of their continued support, we are able to make necessary improvements. We have added to the previous balance of 19,064.70 with this disbursement of \$3,360.07 bringing the total escrow account to 22,424.77. We will continue to add to these funds as they are received to an escrow to be applied to future needed projects. CONSECRATION TO ST. J OSEPH
