SEPTEMBER COLLECTION BENEFITING SEMINARIAN & DIACONATE FORMATION FORMERLY BENEFITING CHRIST THE KING SEMINARY

With the timing of decision to close Christ the King Seminary and the ability to communicate the change with the various parish envelope providers, coupled with the envelope distribution schedule, some of the envelope companies were able to incorporate the change, reflecting "Formation" while some may still reflect "Christ the King Seminary" as the beneficiary. Regardless, the collection is taking place this weekend, September 12 & 13 and will be used for the diocesan Formation operating budget.

The Formation operating budget consist largely of tuition expenses for seminarians and diaconate candidates. Seminarians from our diocese are pursing their studies either at St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore or, if they are a final year seminarian with a May 2021 ordination date, still at Christ the King (but only for this academic year). Diaconate candidates are pursuing their studies through our new collaboration with St. Bernard's School of Theology in Rochester in a combination of in-person classes and remote learning. *Please be generous in giving to this collection.
